### WE NEED VOLUNTEER SHOP STEWARDS AND SHOP ASSISTANTS

Michaels Woodshop is operated by a group of volunteer Shop Stewards comprised of Scouter/Woodworkers. Use of the wood shop is increasing and we need additional volunteers to keep up with the demand. Ideally, Shop Stewards will be experienced woodworkers available to lead or assist with shop activities once or twice a month. We are also seeking volunteer Shop Assistants to help with larger events. Shop Assistants can be older Scouts or adults with little or no woodworking experience who can assist with safety briefings, work flow and limited tool supervision (instruction will be provided). Activities normally last 3-4 hours and are held primarily on weekends.
