Webelos Build It Workshop







August 26, 2021



This workshop is designed for Webelos Dens to complete the Build It Elective in a single session lasting approximately 2 to 2 ½ hours. Parents are expected to attend and are encouraged to assist as needed. The schedule below is based on 6 youth per session.

When Covid restrictions are lifted, the schedule will be re-worked to accommodate up to 8 youth per session. We can arrange multiple sessions to accommodate larger Dens. The cost is \$12.50/youth, which includes all project materials and supplies. If desired, alternative projects may be substituted. The use of alternative projects may impact the time required and the cost of the activity.

10-15 min	Shop Safety: Presentation and discussion about safety risks, injury prevention and personal protective gear.

15 min	Woodworking Tools: Presentation of common woodworking tools. Questions and discussion will be encouraged.

15 min	Discuss Careers in Construction: A short discussion about several construction career options; carpenter, electrician, plumber. If a Den parent works in a construction career, we would encourage them to discuss their career and answer questions in lieu of a more general discussion.		
10-15 min	Select a Project and Discuss Materials: We recommend the tool box and/or wren house projects, although alternative projects are welcome. Leaders should work with the Webelos in advance to pare down the options to one or two projects. Each Webelos will complete one project during the session.		
5-10 min	Break		
60-80 min	Build a Project: Webelos will get their materials and work on their project with instruction and supervision from the volunteer Shop Steward. Parents are encouraged to provide assistance as needed.
