Covid-19 Safety Guidelines

Assess Your Situation

Covid-19 can pose a serious health risk to individuals, especially among those who are not vaccinated, have underlying medical conditions or have other risk factors. Families are advised to assess their individual circumstances before deciding to participate in activities.

Perform a Health Check Before Your Activity

Prior to arrival, all individuals must perform a self-assessment health check by reviewing the [CDC list of Covid-19 Symptoms](#) to confirm the absence of current Covid-19 symptoms.

If You Are Exhibiting or Have Recently Exhibited Symptoms

Please follow the [CDC guidelines on isolating and ending isolation](#) and do not attend a session in the shop until the end of the recommended isolation period.

If You or a Family Member Have Tested Positive for Covid-19

Please DO NOT come to the wood shop during the [CDC recommended quarantine period](#). Regardless of your vaccination status, we respectfully request that everyone follow the guidelines set forth for those who are not up to date on their vaccinations.

Face Coverings are Recommended

We recommend participants bring their own face covering and wear it while in the wood shop. For Unit events, if you prefer to require masks during your event, please let us know and we will support your request.

Physical Distancing

While physical distancing is no longer required in Virginia, we will structure our activities to provide separate work areas for each youth/family group to the extent possible.

Other Items

Participants should use the provided hand sanitizer upon entry into the shop. Sanitizing wipes are available in the shop and may be used by attendees at any time to sanitize tools and other surfaces before use.
