Baloo the Builder Workshop

This workshop is designed to allow Bears to complete the Baloo the Builder requirements in a single session lasting 2 to 2 ½ hours. Dens seeking a shorter activity can arrange an activity focused on a single project, which generally takes 1 to 1 ½ hours to complete.

Parents are expected to attend and to guide/assist as needed. We target 6 to 8 youth per work session. We can arrange multiple sessions to accommodate larger Dens. The cost of this activity is \$12.50/youth, with the projects included below. If desired, alternative projects may be substituted which may impact the time required and the cost of the activity. Dens of 3 or more may reserve an evening session (Mon-Thur) and Dens of 4 or more may reserve weekend times. Individual Cub Scouts or smaller groups can sign up for an Open Registration Session.

20-30 min	Make a fun project: Cub Scouts will make either a Golf Tee Tic Tac Toe Board or a Triangle Golf Tee Challenge Game. Prior to starting, Cub Scouts will practice using a sanding block and clamp.		
15-20 min	Apply a finish: Cub Scouts will apply a clear polyurethane finish to their Tic Tac Toe Boards and will set them aside to dry during the rest of the session		
15-20 min	Useful tools in the tool box: Cubs Scouts will be shown the following tools and their use. Cub Scouts will practice using the hammer and nail punch.
