Participants should dress appropriately for working in the shop: good shoes that cover the entire foot and provide good footing, avoid loose fitting shirts, remove jewelry and watches, tie back or otherwise secure long hair, long pants recommended.

We do not have potable water in the shop. Please bring your own water bottle if desired.

Portable toilets are located adjacent to the shop.

If the small designated parking lot at the west end of the building is full, please note the location of overflow parking spaces near the cabins. Please do not park behind the building in the maintenance yard. Participants do not need to check in at the camp office, but should proceed directly to the shop upon arrival at camp.
