## Covid-19 Disclosure & Safety Guidelines

### **Assess Your Situation**

Covid-19 is a highly transmissible virus and contracting Covid-19 can pose a serious health risk to individuals. We have implemented a number of safety protocols in Michael's Woodshop to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus in the shop, but we are not able to eliminate this risk entirely. Families are advised to assess their individual circumstances before deciding to participate in activities.

### **People At Increased Risk**

People who are at increased risk for severe illness due to age or underlying medical conditions are advised to consult with their medical provider prior to participating in wood shop activities.

### **Perform a Health Check Before Your Activity**

Prior to arrival, all individuals must perform a self-assessment health check by using the [BSA Pre-Event Screening Checklist](#) to confirm the absence of current Covid-19 symptoms. If you are exhibiting symptoms, please DO NOT come to the wood shop. Please simply email us at MichaelsWoodshop.CWBS@gmail.com to inform us of your situation and we will be glad to work with you to schedule a make-up session at the appropriate time.

### **Temperature Check**

A temperature check will be performed upon arrival at Michael's Woodshop. Individuals with temperatures above 100.4 degrees will not be permitted to attend a shop activity. As above, we will work with you to schedule a make-up session at the appropriate time.

### **Face Covering and Other Items**

All participants must bring their own face covering and it must be worn at all times in the wood shop. In addition, we ask participants to use the provided hand sanitizer upon entry into the shop and follow additional safety instructions provided by the volunteer Shop Stewards.
